Dear Friends and Church Family,

We're excited to announce a new member of our family, **Baby Girl Hodges, arriving this November 2025!** Please pray for Abbi to have a safe and healthy delivery.

Thank you for praying for our Bible College. God answered our prayers with **5 new students** this semester, **totaling 20 students**, including a married couple from a Native Indian Reservation in Honduras. They've arrived at our Bible college, with the purpose of being trained to return and start a Bible College among their own people on the reservation. You're probably thinking, "I didn't know Honduras had an Indian Reservation." Well, we didn't either until now! Honduras is full of surprises!



We had a combined youth group of **over 80 teens on campus** with four other churches in Honduras, and I preached on the importance of daily Bible study.

It is a blessing to take turns with our other pastoral staff in preaching at our new church ministry in the capital city, Bethany Baptist Church. I was able to lead **Carlito, age 19**, to Christ after a service. Pray for his recovery from substance abuse.



Besides **Carlito**, we also led **Jeffry**, age 28, to Christ. As I asked him on his front porch about his eternal destiny, he said, "It's amazing that you're talking to me about this, because I almost died last week." He then showed me a picture of his demolished car that he accidentally drove off a cliff into a ravine. Though he was injured, his life was miraculously spared. A few minutes later, Jeffry repented and asked Christ to be his Savior. **Lisbet, Irma, Cynthia, and Angel** also trusted Christ as their Savior during our door-to-door evangelism.

Pray for the salvation of **Loordes, Ilsa, Monserat, Kathia, Leonardo, Marbella, José, and Ramón**, whom we also witnessed to this month.

At our home with 18 bus workers, we planned two goals: to bring at least **70 people on our bus** for four Sundays in a row, and **to knock on every door** in our route's various villages, totaling over 13,000 people, before January.

Finally, **pray for new teachers** for our English Christian school. We're losing four of our nine English teachers, who teach around 235 students. We're thankful for those who have committed to this two-year missionary program. A great opportunity to make a difference is at your doorstep!
