Dear Friends and Church Family,

Thank you for your prayers and support! **Abbi and I saw 13 people saved this month during our evangelism time!** **Isaac and Kevin** were saved during outreach, as well as several whole families together. Here are their stories:

- **Rosy and Tony, brother and sister**, trusted Christ for salvation after they arrived home from work and found us already there making a visit. The next week, Joanna, along with her son Kilber, her cousin Nayeli, and Nayeli's aunt Yami, all trusted Christ as we visited 3 homes next to each other down a hidden dirt road we discovered for the first time. None of them have ever been "church-goers," and they showed real interest in starting. Pray that they'll come.
- **Enemesia (a grandmother), along with Bianca, and Osmani (her two grown-up grandchildren)**, all were saved after we had a lengthy discussion of Catholic purgatory. They were convinced that purgatory was necessary to "purify" us and make us worthy of heaven. After I explained with verses how the blood of Jesus serves that very purpose, all three of them turned from faith in purgatory to faith in Christ's finished work.
- **Elihu and his cousin Joan** got saved in the back of our pick-up truck. You may remember from last October's letter that Elihu had been run over by a motorcycle, which was his catalyst for returning to church. I included his picture again from October.

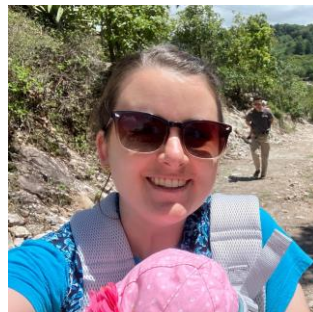
Pray for the salvation of **Joshua and Luz**, whom we also witnessed to on door to door outreach.

I had the joy of baptizing Jeremy and Senya this month, two young Christians with a strong testimony of faith and faithful church attendance.



Grandview Baptist Church from Portland, OR, brought their soul-winning teens to Honduras to preach and teach in several of our public schools. I was able to help translate the gospel in several public elementary and high schools, and **over 100 students made professions of repentance and faith** during our public school visits. We also had **over 200 teens at our combined youth rally**, with over 70 being completely unchurched, and several were saved.
