

Hodges Joseph & Abigail May 2024 in Honduras


Dear Friends and Church Family,

Abbi and I bought a TV screen to project the old-time hymns that we sing, because hymnbooks are costly and often get stolen, and many visitors don't know they hymns by heart yet. Every time we go, we take our Bible college students to help lead singing, give short devotionals, and to teach children. We pray that God might call one of these students to take over in the future.

We taught Children's Church this month. Seven children ages 7-**9 trusted Christ for salvation** after we finished learning of Moses lifting up the bronze serpent to save those bitten by fiery serpents, representing Christ who was also lifted up to save mankind from sin and hell.

Though we're free to teach what we want, unfortunately even private schools here are under strict government regulation as they try to scheme crazy ways to squeeze money from private institutions.
